[May 12, 10:48 AM] Amy M. Burns: My students are studying the Revolutionary War and they used Soundtrap to create a remix of Yankee Doodle.

[May 12, 10:49 AM] Jenny: I work with blind/visually impaired students...and we've found that Soundtrap does not work well with voiceover...just an FYI. They (Soundtrap) tell us they are working to improve that, but for now it's unfortunately challenging to navigate through projects. GB is a little better with voiceover.

[May 12, 10:50 AM] Amy M. Burns: Just to clarify @Julia's comment about saving. Soundtrap has a revision history so you can go back in time and bring up an older version. It will also ask you to save something the next time you login if you did not save.

[May 12, 10:51 AM] Trevor: Have you ever run into issues where your students went to add their own track in (with metronome) and somehow the end result is that the student and the metronome is not in sync?

[May 12, 10:52 AM] Amy M. Burns: @Trevor Were they using headsets of any kind?

[May 12, 10:52 AM] Trevor: Using mic from Chromebook. They were recording their band instrument.

[May 12, 10:52 AM] Julie: I've used headsets and mics and still have lag sometimes. I just end up moving the vocal track a bit to match the beat.

[May 12, 10:52 AM] Amy M. Burns: @Trevor and no headsets?

[May 12, 10:53 AM] Trevor: Do you mean headset with mic or headphones?

[May 12, 10:53 AM] Amy M. Burns: When I record without headsets, it can throw off the alignment.

[May 12, 10:53 AM] Amy M. Burns: @Trevor Recording with headsets so the sound comes through them and not coming out of the device's speaker.
